ORGAN AND TISSUE TRANSPLANT

- You can receive services in the facilities selected by Triple-S Salud in and outside of Puerto Rico.
- You need a precertification for each stage of the transplant: pre-transplant, transplant and post-transplant.
- Some covered transplants are: heart, heart-lung, lung (unilateral or bilateral), liver, pancreas-kidney, kidney, bone marrow among others.

PHARMACY

- The supply of medicines will be of up to 15 days for acute medicines and 30 days for maintenance medications. Includes 5 repetitions for maintenance medications.
- Maintenance medications can be obtained by one of three methods:
 - o 90-day supply thru Prescription Thru Mail Program*
 - o 90-day supply thru select pharmacies*
 - o 30-day supply at your preferred hired pharmacy

^{*}The conditions that qualify for 90-day supply are: Hypertension, Diabetes (insulin and oral tablets), Thyroid, Cholesterol, Epilepsy (Anticonvulsants), Estrogen, Alzheimer's (not applying the patches), Parkinson's, Osteoporosis and Prostate, among others. Other maintenance medications can be requested monthly at your preferred pharmacy.


Triple-S Portal Manage your health and that of your loved ones

If you wish, you can share your medical information with family members or caregivers. In addition, you can request coverage certificate, ID card duplicates, process reimbursements and manage dependents, among other things. You have access to your personal information and that of your underage dependents.

The Importance of the Annual Preventive Checkup

It is always a good time to start taking better care of ourselves. That is why we want to guide you about that annual medical checkup and the most recommended preventive tests.

Why is it important to visit the doctor every year?

- This is one of the most important tools for your health.
- A routine annual visit helps detect problems before they become crises and keeps you up to date with your preventive tests.

What are these essential tests?

They vary by age, medical history, and gender:

- Physical exam
- Blood pressure monitoring
- Weight and body mass index (BMI) evaluation



Are you pregnant?



The "Contigo Mamá" prenatal program offers you educational material about the different stages of pregnancy, nutrition, prenatal care, the delivery and postpartum process, and newborn care, among others. Educational workshops on painless labor and breastfeeding are offered by nutrition and lactation specialists, perinatal educator, and prenatal nurse. These courses are available virtually to anyone diagnosed with pregnancy from the moment they learn about their pregnancy. In addition, you can consume them at your own pace as long as you complete the course before giving birth.

The prenatal nurse will assist you in coordinating other services such as: breastfeeding machine according to your policy, and other required services. Additionally, the prenatal nurse can assist you with questions that you may have during your pregnancy.

Having a primary care physician (PCP) is one of the elements most connected to the quality of your care. This is because if you have a primary care physician, their role is to help you receive coordinated care.

Role of the PCP

The PCP's main role is to help you lead a healthy lifestyle and prevent diseases. Prevention is just as valuable at any age and a reason to have a primary care physician, even if you have a free choice health plan. Medicine is becoming more complex and specialized. That is why patients often have difficulty understanding their conditions and the scope of treatment. When you have a PCP, they help you navigate your care, assess the urgency of your health problems, and guide you on the specialist you should visit. This way you don't waste time visiting a gastroenterologist when you really need to see a cardiologist.

PCP vs. Subspecialist

A PCP can be a general practitioner, family physician, as well as an internist.

The PCP's and the specialist's work complement each other. For example, a patient who is referred to a cardiologist usually arrives with laboratories and a more complete clinical picture than one who goes on his or her own. This helps the specialist save time and achieve a faster diagnosis and treatment.

Who benefits from having a PCP?

We all benefit from having a PCP, because when we go from specialist to specialist the continuity of care is affected. In these cases, specialists, not knowing your entire history, will most likely order laboratory tests and imaging scans that you may already have in your record with your primary care physician. This represents a higher expense in deductibles and a possible delay in your treatment. Likewise, your PCP can ensure that you're not taking a medication that may interact with any other medication you're taking or treatment you're in.



In recent years, we have been seeing the rise of urgent care centers in the island. But if one asks the difference between an urgent care center and an emergency room, few people can explain it. It is important that you know their differences and when each one should be visited.

The main difference is in the severity of the cases they treat. An emergency room is designed to treat health situations that put a person's life in imminent danger, such as a heart attack or severe asthma.

In contrast, an urgent care center treats situations that require quick attention, but that are not necessarily life threatening.

EXAMPLES OF EMERGENCIES

In addition to chest pressure or chest pain that raise the suspicion of a heart attack, the following are considered emergencies:

- Sudden, severe pain in the stomach area
- Uncontrolled blood pressure
- Loss of consciousness
- Trouble breathing
- Sudden headache or headache that is accompanied by nausea
- Numbness, tingling, or loss of movement in one part of the body, especially if it is in one part of the body. Unable to speak coherently.


- Sudden changes in vision
- A wound with severe bleeding
- A severe burn
- Fractures, especially if the bone is visible

EXAMPLES OF URGENCIES

- Earache
- Eve infection
- Sprained ankle
- Severe sore throat
- Vomiting/diarrhea
- Back pain, painful muscle spasms

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF VISITING THE URGENT CARE CENTER WHEN IT IS NOT A TRUE EMERGENCY?

- First and foremost, you are freeing up resources to deal with true emergencies.
- Also, you will probably have a shorter wait in an urgent care center. We must remember that emergency rooms operate on a triage basis. This means it is not a first-come, first-served basis; the most serious cases are seen first. If you have a cold and go to the emergency room, you will have a longer wait, since a cold is not considered a priority.
- Lastly, urgent care centers have lower copayments than emergency rooms.

EFFECTIVE SAVINGS

Generic drugs tend to cost less than brand-name drugs because they do not have to repeat clinical studies already conducted by brand-name drug manufacturers to demonstrate their safety and effectiveness. This way you can save on your medical expenses without compromising your health.

ACUTE DRUGS

Used to treat a sudden illness of short duration that have a clearly defined time of start and end. In general, we cover up to a maximum supply of fifteen (15) days with no refills.

MAINTENANCE DRUGS

Are those that treat a life-long health problems such as diabetes, thyroid, asthma, and Parkinson's Disease, among others. These drugs are covered for 30 days supply and up to a maximum of five (5) refills. Some of these drugs may also be filled in an extended 90 days supply (and one refill).

You will get your drugs at your place of choice in Puerto Rico or USVI. You may arrange to have them sent to your home, physician's office, or any other place for pick-up.

OTC Program

Triple-S Salud has added in most of its prescription drug coverages some OTC drug alternatives; without \$0 copay to you.

These choices are of great benefit for you because you can have access to effective drugs with a lower cost in your pharmacological therapy.

To take advantage of this program and to ensure that you are using an appropriate therapy, you must submit a prescription from your doctor for dispensing of the OTC drug.

Tell your doctor that he needs to write in the prescription the name of the drug followed by OTC.

- 3. The provider will verify your eligibility and your policy deductibles, coinsurance, and conditions. The provider will then bill their local BlueCross BlueShield.
- 4. You will pay the deductible and coinsurance corresponding to your benefit in the United States.
- 5. The BCBS plan in the area the service was provided will pay the provider and send Triple-S Salud the insurance claim electronically.
- 6. Triple-S Salud will reimburse the BCBS plan. They will also mail you a report with the explanation of provided services.

Coordination of Benefits

WHAT IS COORDINATION OF BENEFITS?

- Avoids payments in excess when health care is covered by two or more health plan policies.
- The payment of deductibles and coinsurances left to pay by the primary plan, will be assumed by your secondary plan when the payment does not outpace the net payment amount if only you had a primary plan. The payment policy will apply as stated by the contract.
- This also applies to any request of reimbursements you have made where you could recover the whole or the maximum possible of the cost of the care received.



HOW DO I PAY THE DEDUCTIBLES AND COINSURANCES?

- a. **Traditional way** (Medicare) Triple-S Salud pays the
 deductibles and coinsurances left
 to pay for Medicare, applying the
 payment policy.
- b. Triple- S Salud with another
 Triple-S Salud plan or an external private plan the payment of deductibles and coinsurances left to pay for the primary plan, will be assumed by the secondary plan if and when this payment does not outpace the amount of the net payment that would have made this same policy if only this were your primary plan. The payment policy applies.
- c. Preserving benefits payment for the secondary takes as its basis the comparison of the net payment of your primary with the net payment of your secondary plan, as if the latter is primary
